



# Nantucket Fire Department Charcoal & Gas Grill Fire Permit Rules and Regulations

1. This permit is valid for charcoal grill and gas grill fires only.
2. **Bonfires and wood fires are not permitted anywhere on Nantucket.**
3. This permit cannot be used on any of the public beaches or other beaches patrolled by lifeguards, within their boundaries or jurisdiction marked by signs—while the lifeguards are on duty.
4. Permitted fires on Tuckernuck are restricted to “Whale Point.”
5. This permit is only valid for one year from the date issued.
6. The fee for this permit shall be \$5.00. Permits are free for persons over the age of 65 upon presentation of proof of age.
7. This permit is only valid when authorized by the signature of the officer on duty.
8. This permit must be in the possession of the authorized holder while using the permit and must be presentable upon the request of any officer of the police or fire department.
9. Holder of this permit must be at least 18 years of age.
10. Failure to comply with the above mentioned regulations will result in indefinite suspension of the permit and possible court action under the general laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

I hereby state that I, the permit holder, have read and fully understand the above mentioned regulations and that by signing my name on the permit, I will be fully responsible for the charcoal or gas grill fire.
