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EMERGENCY DECLARATION

WHEREAS, a sudden, generally unexpected occurrence of circumstances demanding public action has arisen within the Town of Nantucket; and

WHEREAS, The Town Manager, of the Town of Nantucket, Massachusetts, upon advice from the Director of Emergency Management, has determined that the incident poses a present, reasonable and imminent danger to public health, safety, or general welfare of the people of the Town of Nantucket or their property so that it has become necessary for the Director to utilize and coordinate the services, equipment, supplies, and facilities of existing departments, offices, and agencies or the community for the purposes of emergency management and emergency functions; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works has determined that it is necessary for parking to be banned and vehicles to be removed from certain streets within the Town of Nantucket in order to facilitate the removal of snow or debris; and

WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Board of Selectmen has designated the Town Manager, after consultation with the various public safety departments of the Town, to be responsible to determine whether a Declaration of Emergency and subsequent closing of ways is warranted; and

WHEREAS, the people of the community of Nantucket should be able to depend upon guidance from their Chief Municipal Official,

NOW THEREFORE, I, C. Elizabeth Gibson, Town Manager for the Town of Nantucket, Massachusetts, hereby declare that as of 10:00 PM, March 12, 2018 a State of Emergency exists in the community of Nantucket. This Declaration of Emergency shall remain in effect until notice is given, pursuant to my judgement that the State of Emergency no longer exists.

FURTHERMORE, having determined that in order to facilitate the removal of snow or debris, afford public safety agencies unhindered access to areas of the Town while responding to emergencies or in order to provide protection to the public, it is necessary to declare, in accordance with Chapter 127, Article IV § 127-14 of the Code of the Town of Nantucket, that a State of Emergency Exists and a Parking Ban shall be in effect from 12:01 AM, March 13, 2018 through 11:59 PM, March 13, 2018 on the streets and intersections listed in the attachment to this declaration.
