Town Manager Libby Gibson has declared that a "Snow Emergency" exists for the Town of Nantucket effective as of 12:01 AM, Tuesday, March 13, 2018. As part of the emergency declaration a Parking Ban has been declared to be in effect for roadways where at least one (1) sign prohibits parking for the purpose of facilitating snow removal. The parking ban is in effect from 12:01 AM, Tuesday, March 13, 2018 through 11:59 PM, Tuesday, March 13, 2018.

The Nantucket Police Department will be attempting to contact owners of vehicles found to be parking in violation of the parking ban in an attempt to have them move their vehicles. However, vehicles not removed by 12:01 AM, Tuesday, March 13, 2018 may be towed at the owner's expense upon order of the Police Department (Town of Nantucket Traffic Rules and Regulations, Chapter 200, Section 200.2.5)

Emergency Management anticipates higher than normal flood tides on Tuesday around 10:00 AM. Significant flooding is expected on Washington St., Francis St., Easy St., Lower Broad St., and the Brant Point area. Motorist are reminded that the flood waters are salt water and should avoid driving through the flooded areas. Residents with homes in low lying areas affected by flooding from the Harbor should consider seeking alternate shelter for Monday night through the Tuesday high tide which is expected to be at 10:48 PM Tuesday.

Emergency Management does not anticipate opening the emergency shelter at this time. Please tune into your local radio station or Inky Alerts for updated information or tune into Nantucket's Public Information Radio, FM 105.5 WNPD for continuous updates.
