**a. 2020 Long Range Transportation Plan – Proposed bike and pedestrian Improvements**

**b. Proposed Micro Transportation / Bike Share Licensing**

-The group reviewed the draft regulations for private micro mobility licensing  
-Harvey Y suggested holidays be included for enforcement of parked bikes.  
-Jason B suggested there was general support but that licensing should limit the number of businesses.

**c. Proposed Electric Bicycle Legislation**

-Jason B summarized the draft state legislation that would categorize types of ebikes and establish restrictions on certain types.

**d. Annual Town Meeting Citizen Bicycle Right of Way Warrant Article**

-Ian G provided edits to the Article 71 that would remove signage requirements at driveways.

-Motion (Dave F/Jason B) – Support as is with the need to delete reference to Chapter 57 Section 15 at Town meeting if needed.

-Vote: 5-1 with Kevin M opposed.

e. Intown Bike Path

1. Update on Future Phases – Orange Street and Washington Street  
-no discussion of this item

2. Lighting improvement options on existing path  
-Dave F has pricing for a system. Further review of funding sources is needed.  
-Kevin M suggested if the route is being encouraged, then lighting should be provided.  
-Consensus to test lighting.
