

ADVISORY COMMITTEE OF NONVOTING TAXPAYERS
Minutes of Public meeting 10 A.M., SATURDAY, August 5, 2023 at Meeting Trailer
Room A - 131 Pleasant St. and via Zoom

1. Attending members: Kathy Baird, Gary Beller, Gene Briskman, Patti Deuster, Lynn Filipski, Bill Gardner, Don Green, Peter Halle, Peter Kahn, Donna Martino, Steve Perelman, Pam Suan, and Scott Ulm. Members absent: Lou Bassano, and Ralph Kunch. A quorum was present.
2. At 10:02 AM the Chair Peter Halle convened the meeting and read the Virtual Meeting Script confirming a quorum was present.
3. The Agenda for today's meeting was moved for approval, seconded and passed unanimously.
4. Approval of the minutes from the July 22, 2023 meeting was moved, seconded and passed unanimously.
5. Peter Halle introduced Mike Burns (Transportation Project Manager) who gave a presentation titled Long-Range Transportation Plan Update – Visioning and Prioritization Survey Results, which was based on the overall town transportation planning that can be found [here](#). The presentation included the overall plan, public surveys and results, prioritization, public participation through the town's ZenCity Outreach platform, with the final public review of and input to the draft LRTP to continue through August 21. Mr. Burns answered questions from members and other attendees after the presentation.
6. Peter Kahn gave an overview of the current status of the STR Working Group, explaining the lack of progress that has characterized the last two Select Board meetings where the topic was discussed by the board and feedback was taken from the public. It is unclear at this point whether the STR Bylaw Package will move forward with an apparently split Board and no specific changes yet proposed. ACNVT will continue to advocate its position in support of Articles 1 and 2 and opposition to Article 3 which has an acceptable alternative already present in Article 2.
7. Steve Perelman gave an update on progress of the Public Relations committee and it was agreed that all members will submit their top non-voting taxpayer issues to Kathy who will collect and send to Peter H. for discussion at the next meeting. Lynn Filipski offered to create a survey of non-voting taxpayers should the group vote to do so.
8. Peter H. will reach out to new Select Board members to speak with ACNVT at future meetings.
9. Next ACNVT meeting is scheduled via Zoom/Hybrid at the Meeting Trailer at 10am August 19, 2023.
10. Motion to adjourn was seconded and passed unanimously at 12:35 pm.
