Golding - How much sand will be required for dune building/restoration? Ans. Not known yet. Volume will be determined in design phase. Will need sand transport study.

Brace - Must not smother eelgrass with sand transfer in harbor. Need to study effects of sand in bends and how will effect spits. Better to put sand on outside of Coatue.

Roche - Sand management is a political issue. Where from and at what cost.
