

**ADVISORY COMMITTEE OF NONVOTING TAXPAYERS**  
**Minutes of Public meeting 10 A.M., SATURDAY, September 2, 2023 at Meeting**  
**Trailer Room A - 131 Pleasant St. and via Zoom**

1. Attending members: Kathy Baird, Gary Beller, Patti Deuster, Lynn Filipiski, Bill Gardner, Don Green, Peter Halle, Peter Kahn, Ralph Kuncel, Donna Martino, Steve Perelman, and Scott Ulm. Member absent: Lou Bassano, Gene Briskman, Pam Suan. A quorum was present.
2. At 10:00 AM the Vice Chair Peter Kahn convened the meeting and Kathy Baird read the Virtual Meeting Script confirming a quorum was present.
3. The Agenda for today's meeting was moved for approval, seconded and passed unanimously.
4. Approval of the minutes from the August 19, 2023 meeting was moved, seconded and passed unanimously.
5. Peter Kahn opened the meeting to discuss the most important issues to non-voting taxpayers, as submitted by members. Donna Martino gave an overview of the latest progress on and planning for the Town Council Study Committee.
6. Gary Beller provided an update on CRAC report on timeline of and issues surrounding actions to minimize the impacts, extraordinary costs, and acquisition of funding for climate change.
7. Peter Kahn introduced the public safety issue for discussion, covering E-bike regulations, bicycles and additional rotaries such as the recently proposed one at the Milestone and Nobadeer Farm Road intersection.
8. The noise and nuisance issue was discussed in terms of actionable items that could be accomplished, such as noise dampening of pool equipment, infrastructure, congestion and limiting construction during the high season.
9. Steve Perelman provided an update on Public Relations outreach and asked how meeting guests heard about today's meeting. All replied: Nantucket Current
10. Peter Kahn provided an update on the STR bylaws, including Select Board changes including the removal of the bi-directional linkage between Articles 1 and 2. The former STRWG continues to meet informally to craft messaging to support both articles, including FAQs. The Planning Board (Article 2) and Finance Committee (all articles) will weigh in with their recommendations in the next few weeks on the warrant. Peter announced public outreach sessions planning for the STR articles on 10/5 & 12. Kathy explained the selection/process for the STR registry portal vendor.
11. Next ACNVT meeting scheduled via Hybrid/Zoom in the meeting trailer (131 Pleasant Street) at 10am Saturday October 7, 2023 with outreach to Chief Pittman for our next meeting as well as Josh Balling as a future speaker. Other suggestions included Jessie Bell from the Land Bank and the Nantucket Conservation Foundation.
12. Motion to adjourn was seconded and passed unanimously at 11:48 am.
