BOARD OF HEALTH: SUPPLEMENTAL AMENDMENT TO EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 1 -TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON ALL CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

Dear Nantucket Community:

In response to communication from Senator Julian Cyr’s office confirming the Town’s local authority relative to the Governor’s Stay at Home Order, the Nantucket Board of Health held an emergency remote participation meeting at 3:00 PM on Monday, March 30, 2020.

The purpose of this emergency meeting was to discuss a supplemental amendment to the Board’s *Emergency Order No. 1 - Temporary Moratorium on all Construction Projects on Nantucket* issued on March 18, 2020. This supplemental amendment limits construction and landscaping to emergency work only to prevent the Coronavirus from spreading. This supplemental amendment was approved unanimously.
