BOARD OF HEALTH: REVISED SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Today the Nantucket Board of Health held an emergency remote participation meeting at 3:30 PM to address concerns over the its March 30, 2020 Supplemental Order.

The purpose of this emergency meeting was to consider the removal of language permitting landscaping and construction by single workers at unoccupied property - in continued efforts to prevent the Coronavirus from spreading. The revision to this supplemental amendment was approved unanimously.
